Participation for a group of teenagers in a tournament	the number of players and the travel each one needs
A national tournament stage	tables and sittings, Trainer and Banker time, venue and materials
A school club for one school year	the teacher's training, one kit per school and the support across the year
Trainer training in a new country or city	the size of the cohort and its supervised practice

Each item is quoted from the lines named here, and the figure with its breakdown comes in the reply to your enquiry. Tell us the group size and the city and the reply carries a number.

WHAT A FUNDER GETS BACK

1. A named place in the event record. Every tournament has its own page listing organizers, partners and supporting clubs by name. That page stays up.
2. Photographs. The 2026 Ottawa stage has a full photo set, credited to its photographer; the earlier stages carry the organizer's photograph from the day on their own page.
3. A written report on the event you funded — what took place, where, how many participants, from which cities and countries, who won.
4. Presence at the event itself, where the format allows it — previous tournaments have had an ambassador, ministry representatives and university hosts in the room.
